**An Ordinance to Amend the Code by Adding “Outdoor Recreation Facility” as a

Supervisor called the Public Hearing to order at 7:42 P.M. and the Town Clerk read the notice that was published in the Daily News.

The Supervisor opened the hearing to the public. Harriett Worthington asked what this amendment was all about. The Supervisor explained that this to add “Outdoor Recreation Facility” as an allowed use with a Special Use Permit in a Commercial District. Mrs. Worthington would like the Town Board to consider the residents and explained the noise they are experiencing from the motor cross track on Harloff Road.

Joseph Jaszko expressed that if this is allowed it would be setting a precedent. Clinton Worthington, Building Inspector explained it is already allowed in the Agricultural-Residential District (referring to the motor cross track area) but not in a Commercial District. This would allow it in a Commercial District with Special Use Permit. Tonight it is only to add it to the Commercial District. Anyone requesting an Outdoor Recreation Facility in this district would have to make the proper application to the Code Enforcement Officer.

Supervisor Post declared the Public Hearing closed at 7:48 P.M. as no one else spoke for or against the Ordinance to Amend the Code to Add “Outdoor Recreation Facility” as a Use Requiring a Special Use Permit
