Paul McCullough made a motion to approve the minutes as submitted. Seconded by Jeremy Liles. Vote unanimous for approval.

MICHAEL HORST—3936 SO MAIN ST RD—SPECIAL USE PERMIT—WORM FARM

Mr. Horst appeared before the Board to obtain a Special Use Permit—Home Occupation—to operate a worm farm at the above location. This item was tabled at the July 17, 2012 meeting. Gordon Offhaus made a motion to remove the item from the table. Seconded by Paul Marchese. Vote unanimous to remove from table.

Mr. Horst proposes to operate a worm farm in his basement. It was first stated it would be in his garage. But the temperature is more even in the basement so he has decided to not use the garage.

An email was received from Christian Bartz of Fairview Dr indicating his concern of smell. Mr. Horst advised that there will be no smell as the operation is strictly in the basement. Genesee County Planning Dept. recommended approval.

Paul Marchese made a motion to approve the Home Occupation I. Seconded by Jeremy Liles. Vote unanimous for approval.

PAUL GREFRATH— HUNTERS LANDING—8348 LEWISTON RD—SIGN PERMIT An application was presented to obtain approval to erect an arrow pole with a light attached as a free standing sign to be located next to the building at the above location. This will be the third sign on the premises. The Zoning Board of Appeals approved the third sign. A discussion ensued with that Board in regards to whether it really is a sign. The vote was three (3) to two (2) for approval.

The Planning Board discussed the fact that this is a pre-existing non conforming lot. Allowing this would make it more non-conforming. Site plan approval is needed by the Planning Board. Front yard set back is 22.84—50 ft. required; rear yard setback is 46.24–50 ft required; side yard setbacks are 38 ft and 57 ft.—30 ft. required; frontage is 115 ft—200 ft. required; lot area is 20,255 S/F—40,000 S/F required. Genesee County Planning Dept. recommended approval. Don Partridge made a motion to approve the sign permit as depicted in the picture presented with the application. Seconded by Jeremy Liles. Vote unanimous for approval.

## ZEO REPORT

Alpina will be submitting a sign application in September. The ZEO is trying to arrange for the Planning Board to tour Alpina and Marktec in the near future. Foreclosure of property—the ZEO advised that 1307 of the NYS Code allows for municipalities to maintain property that is being foreclosed on and charge the maintenance back to the property owners.
