

#### Batavia Town Park Planning & Design Workshop Summary

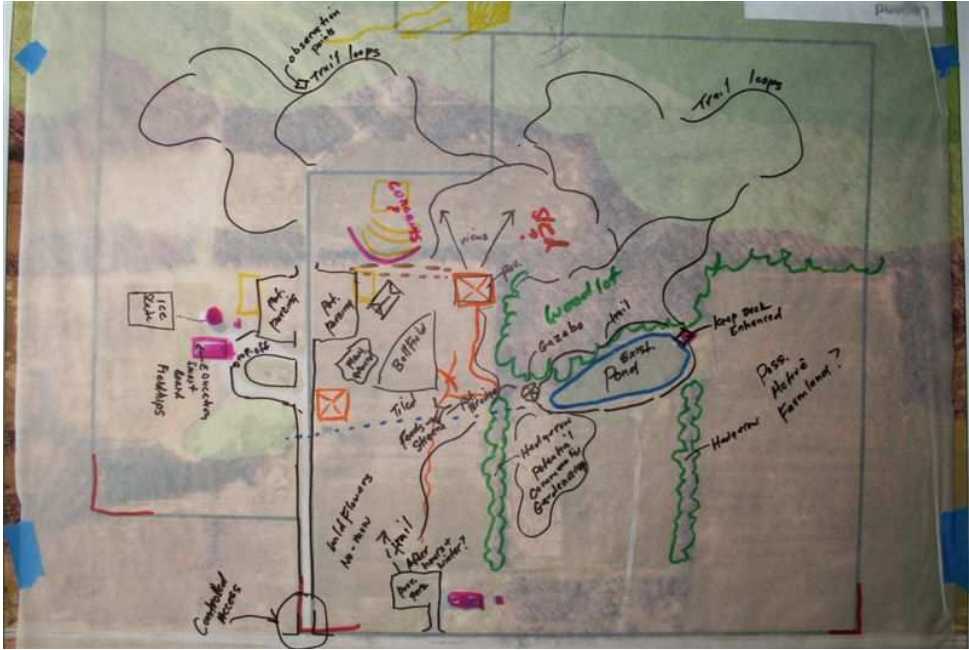
A "Park Workshop" was held at the Batavia Town Hall on January 27, 2010.

Stuart I. Brown Associates, Ingalls Planning & Design and Steve Mountain presented on the Park site along with some issues and opportunities that need to be considered when planning and designing the park.

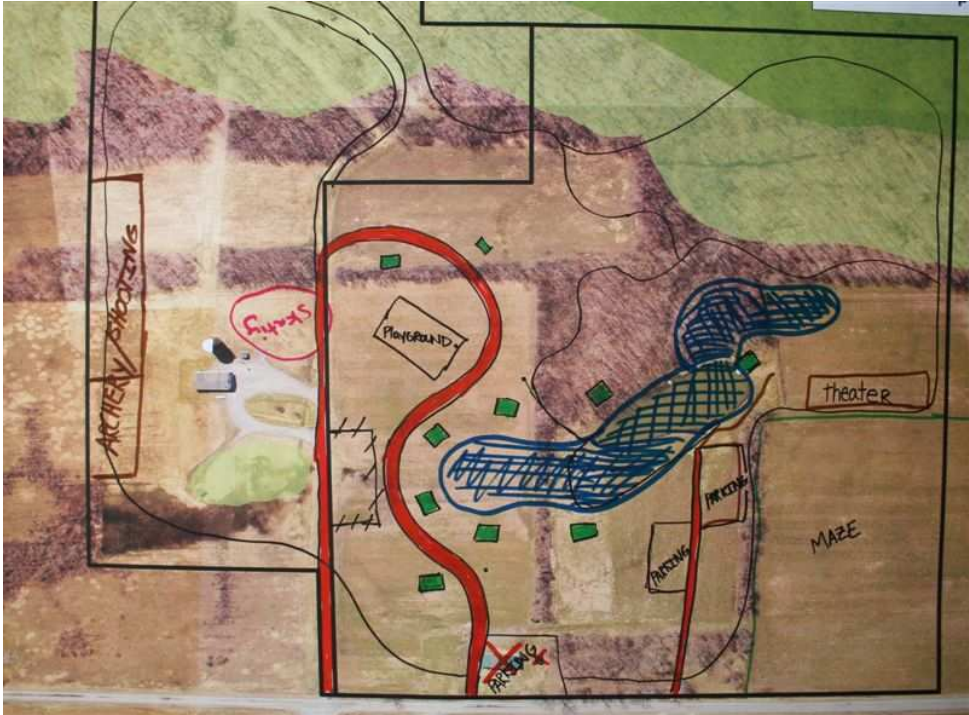
Community members after the presentation were put into two groups to brainstorm ideas for facilities at the new park and prepare a concept site plan. Everyone that attended had great ideas that ranged from, but not limited to, "passive" recreational facilities, such as picnic areas, nature trails, fishing pond shaped to look like a water animal, community garden and a seasonal corn maze. At this time, the park is not envisioned to include athletic fields for use by organized sports but having a large graded grass area for multi use purposes. The Town hopes to establish partnerships with schools, Boy Scouts, Girl Scouts, 4-H and others to develop programs or facilities at the park. We encourage you to share any ideas you may have about what the park should include.
