PUBLIC HEARING FEBRUARY 3, 2009

RE: GENESEE VALLEY AGRI BUSINESS PARK – ROADWAY AND STORM WATER  
MANAGEMENT FACILITY

The public hearing was called to order at 7:30 pm by Chairman Kathleen Jasinski. The notice, as published in the Batavia Daily News, was read by the Secretary.

The purpose of the public hearing is for the development of a roadway and storm water management facility in the Genesee Valley Agri Business Park – 5142 E. Main St. Rd.

Chad Zambito from GCEDC and Steve Tanner from Clark Patterson Lee gave a summary of the proposed park. One (1) potential candidate, a Canadian food processing business, has expressed interest. This business would create approx. 100 jobs.

Sue Berardini of 8787 Haven Lane asked from the audience how would this project affect this residential area? Mr. Zambito stated that the Planning Board has set limitations for odor, noise and etc.

Mrs. Berardini asked, how will it be controlled? Mr. Zambito stated that odor can be controlled by filtration stacks/burning to keep odors on sight.

Dave Hopkins of 4877 Ellicott St. Rd. asked is Oatka Milk incorporated into this project?

Steve Tanner stated that Oatka Milk is going to part of phase 3 of this project.

Total phase build out of this park will be 15-20 years.

When no further questions or opinions were expressed, the public hearing was closed at 7:41pm.
