PUBLIC HEARING FEBRUARY 3, 2009

RE: GENESEE VALLEY AGRI BUSINESS PARK – STORM WATER MANAGEMENT POND

The public hearing was called to order at 7:41pm by Chairman Kathleen Jasinski. The notice, as published in the Batavia Daily News, was read by the Secretary

The purpose of this public hearing is to obtain a Special Use Permit to allow storm water management ponds in the Genesee Valley Agri Business Park.

Steve Tanner from Clark Patterson Lee advised the Board the ponds are required by DEC.

They will be located south of the railroad and running south. Water will also mitigate to the south. They are staying out of the wooded and wet areas.

Sue Berardini of 8787 Haven Lane asked where is the pond compared to where I live?

Mrs. Berardini was shown on the map the distance between her home and the proposed ponds.

The purpose of the ponds is that they will hold water back and release it over a period of time.

Dave Hopkins of 4877 Ellicott St. Rd. asked what about mosquitoes? Steve Tanner stated that it is a concern but the ponds are a requirement.

When no further questions or comments were expressed, the public hearing was closed at 7:50pm.
