Councilman Gerace, Acting Chair called the Public Hearing to order at 7:03 P.M. and the Town Clerk read the notice that was published in the Daily News.

Joseph Huber addressed the Town Board. He asked what side of the road the water main would be on, the distance from the driveways and if the properties involved would be restored. Mr. Huber is concerned because he has a concrete driveway and approximately 730 feet of frontage that would be affected.

Councilman Lang said that the water main shown on the Map, Plan & Report appears to be on the west side of Alexander Road. The Highway Superintendent said that usually the water main is placed within six feet of the edge of the road. The properties that are disturbed by the water main construction will be restored.

Michael Sabatino questioned "Exhibit A" boundaries, as to what all the "18" numbers represented. It was explained that they represent the Section, Block and Lot of the parcels.

Councilman Gerace asked if anyone had any further questions. He also stated that the Town Engineer would be available on Monday, if anyone wished to contact him.

Councilman Gerace declared the Public Hearing closed at 7:15 P.M. as no one spoke for or against the Establishment of the Alexander/Pike Roads Water District.
