The Supervisor called the meeting to order at 6:55 P.M and opened the meeting for public comment on the Supplement Public Hearing for the Establishment of the Alexander/Pike Roads Water District as published in the Daily News.

The Supervisor reiterated that this public hearing is a formality due to the change in the loan and grant amount.

**Francis Bartz** asked when the water project is expected to begin. The Supervisor advised that it could be as early as Spring 2009.

**Leonard Tomaszewski** who owns vacant land on Pike Road questioned how this affects him because his property has no access to the Road. The Supervisor was unable to give a positive answer, it may be exempt if there is no road frontage but advised Mr. Tomaszewski to contact the Town Engineer and he would be able to readily answer that question.

**Joseph Huber** questioned the side of the road the waterline will be on because he is concerned with his concrete driveway being disrupted and not restored properly. The Supervisor stated that they take in consideration of the least amount of obstructions and that assists in determining where the waterline will be installed. Also, a retainer is held to be sure the restoration is taken care of.

Supervisor Post declared the Public Hearing closed at 7:00 P.M. as no one else spoke for or against the Supplement Establishment of the Alexander/Pike Roads Water District.
