Supervisor called the Public Hearing to order at 7:05 P.M. and opened the meeting for public comment and assistance on the project the Town is considering for inclusion in an application for funding under the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program, as published in the Daily News.

The Supervisor explained that the Town is seeking funding to assist in the financing from the CDBG program for the construction of sewer conveyance along West Main Street Road in the area of the former Duro Shed property to Batavia Mobile Home Park. The Town is considering moving forward with an application to assist with the project to keep it to an affordable level. This would be a direct solution for the residents and homeowners. Three quarters of the residents have less than reasonable options for their sanitary sewer disposal due to the high water levels. This would reduce cost for the sanitary sewer conveyance and failure with traditional septic systems. It would also increase their quality of life.

Supervisor Post declared the Public Hearing closed at 7:10 P.M. as no one attended to offer comment and assistance to the Town on the project being considered for inclusion in an application for funding under the CDBG Program
