Supervisor called the Public Hearing to order at 6:55 P.M. and opened the meeting for public comment and assistance to the Town in defining community development priorities for inclusion in an application for funding under the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program, as published in the Daily News.

The Town is considering submitting an application for funding under the CDBG program to request funds to assist low and moderate income households to connect to the West Main Street Road sewer system in response to the Unified Funding Cycle issued by the State of New York. The Supervisor expressed that this would reduce out of pocket expense from approximately 75 families who are financially bound.

Supervisor Post declared the Public Hearing closed at 7:00 P.M. as no one attended to offer assistance to the Town in defining community development priorities and possible projects for inclusion in an application for funding under the CDBG Program.
