**WHEREAS**, the Town has installed new water and sewer mains which will require will need routine maintenance and require a truck that has a lift crane to move heavy equipment and pull sewer pump station pumps. Since they currently do not have this type of vehicle a used utility truck would suit their needs.

**WHEREAS**, the Highway Superintendent solicited bids for a used utility truck, bids were reviewed and Western Specialty Vehicle Sales was the low bidder for a used 2002 international 4300 utility truck with a 6000 lb crane.

**WHEREAS**, the Highway Superintendent reviewed this truck with the Town Engineer and Water Department personnel and they recommend purchasing the used 2002 international 4300 utility truck from Western Specialty Vehicle Sales, 520 W. Coal City Road, Braidwood Illinois at a price of \$16,658.00
