The purpose of the public hearing is to obtain approval pertaining to Maximum Height allowed for an addition to the manufacturing facility that will be 48 feet in height where 40 feet is allowed.


Tom Burke, plant engineer for O-AT-KA, was present and explained that they would like to build a two story building with the 1<sup>st</sup> floor being used for batch blending manufacturing capability for all the different products that they make and the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor is for additional specialized milk manufacturing with specialized equipment. The upper floor is smaller than other structures on this property which have already been granted height variances.
