

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
OFFICE OF COMMUNITY RENEWAL GRANT PROGRAM**

NOTICE IS HEREBY given that the Batavia Town Board will hold a public hearing on July 21, 2021 at 7:05 P.M. at the Town of Batavia Town Hall, 3833 West Main Street Road, Batavia for the purpose of hearing public comments on the Town of Batavia community development needs, and to discuss the possible submission of one or more Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) applications for the 2021 program year. The CDBG program is administered by the New York State Office of Community Renewal (OCR), and will make available to eligible local governments approximately \$20,000,000 for the 2021 program year for housing, economic development, public facilities, public infrastructure, and planning activities, with the principal purpose of benefitting low/moderate income persons. The hearing will provide further information about the CDBG program and will allow for citizen participation in the development of any proposed grant applications and/or to provide technical assistance to develop alternate proposals. Comments on the CDBG program or proposed project(s) will be received at this time. The hearing is being conducted pursuant to Section 570.486, Subpart I of the CFR and in compliance with the requirements of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended.

The hearing facilities are accessible to persons with disabilities.
